Jesus is His Name

Advent and Christmas is our yearly reminder to reorient our lives, reprioritize if we must, and to make sure Jesus is at the center. The message the angel of the Lord delivered to the shepherds about him, so that they'd seek after him was this, "to you is born this day in the city of David a Savior, who is the Messiah, the Lord." (Luke 2:11 NRSV)

Savior / Messiah / Lord - Jesus is his name.

Savior - Who we are talking about? Lord Jesus Christ recurs 62x in the New Testament. Joseph and Mary gave him the name Savior at the angel's instruction. "SAVIOR" comes from the name Yeshua (Jesus) which means "YHWH is salvation." God's saving power and grace is embedded even in his name - Jesus. Jesus has saved us and from far more than inconvenience, bad taste, wasted time AND FOR far more than convenience, pleasure, cost, and efficiency. Jesus saved us from sin, which wreaks havoc in us, in our relationships with God, others and ourselves, and eventually destroys us. He saves us from ourselves , and from lasting separation from God. The message given to Joseph was "She will bear a son, and you are to name him Jesus, for he will save his people from their sins." (Matthew 1:21 NRSV). Some say, "I don't need a savior...there's nothing to be saved from or forgiven for... I don't need another to save me, I can handle it myself...I don't want a savior, I'm fine. "He came to what was his own, and his own people did not accept him." (John 1:11 NRSV). God sending a Savior into the world to rescue us confirms the need that we have. Charles Spurgeon preached, "I have a great need for Christ. I have a great Christ for my need."

Messiah - The King rules the kingdom. Jesus is the Anointed One. The Messiah king bringing the kingdom of God as the promised descendant of David. Christmas is THE announcement that there's another King, not Herod, Caesar, or any other, and he is the world's true king. But a different sort of King. Every time we read in the NT, "Christ" or "Jesus Christ", we're reading "Messiah", translated and understood as King Jesus. The Messiah was promised, but Jesus is not what was expected. Not what Mary & Joseph expected. A baby in poverty, virtual obscurity, Joseph's son, who eats with sinners, heals on Sabbath, was crucified like a thief, and rose again on the third day? Let's not let our expectations of what we think God should do, or what God should be, keep us from the reality of who God is and what God HAS done for us when he came near in Jesus. Hark the herald angels sing Glory to....the newborn king!!!

Lord - means he has authority to rule. Lord of all and Lord of my Life. "For to us a child is born, to us a son is given, and the government will be on his shoulders. And he will be called Wonderful Counselor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace." (Isaiah 9:6 NIV). As Lord, it's all on his shoulders! Lord means HE has the lead. The LORD is my Shepherd, he leads me, he makes me, he comforts me, he prepares for me, the Lord is my Light and my Salvation. To what else or whom else do we bow or give our allegiance, our affections, our devotion, commitment and life? Who else, what else is worthy? What or who is at the center? Everything bows before Jesus who is the Lord. Because he is the Lord every knee will bow and every tongue confess Jesus is Lord - to the glory of God the Father (Philippians 2:10-11).

Jesus is his name. Let's worship him this season as our Savior, our Messiah, and our Lord! Cliff Burris

ADULT CHRISTMAS PARTY



Enjoy a time of fellowship. Hope to see you there.


