Greetings in Christ to God's Children;

It with great pleasure that I again am privileged to write this article for the newsletter. This month I would like to lift up God's Word first and then I may be able to tell you where I see God's Children carrying out his word.

Scripture: Ephesians 4: 11-16 As we read this scripture we are reminded that many are sent to equip the saints for the work of ministry, for building up the body of Christ, until we all attain to the unity of the faith and of the knowledge of the Son of God, to mature manhood, to the measure of the stature of the fullness of Christ, so that we may no longer be children, tossed to and fro by the waves and carried about by every wind of doctrine, by human cunning, by craftiness in deceitful schemes. 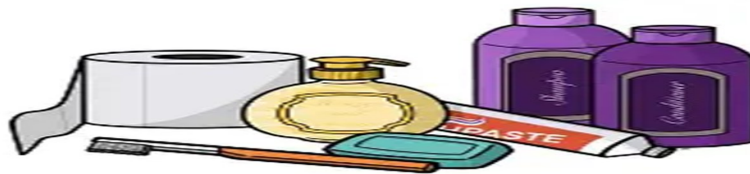
